

To students of the Graduate School of Economics and Management-Information regarding face-to-face classes

- Please take care of your health and physical condition and take your temperature every morning. If you have symptoms such as a cold or fever, refrain from coming to school.
- Wear a mask when you leave your home (including when you go to school or are studying on campus).
- When entering the Faculty of Economics Building and the General Lecture Building, be sure to have your temperature taken with the thermo camera installed, and record the displayed body temperature. If you have a temperature of 37.5 degrees or higher, or one degree higher than your normal temperature, please do not enter the building and call the Academic Affairs Section (022-795-6265 / 6266). When using the seminar room of the Faculty of Letters or the Faculty of Education, please use the thermo camera or QR code installed at the entrance of each building.
- Face the wall in the elevator and do not engage in conversation with others. Please use the stairs as much as possible to move between floors.
- When waiting in front of the toilet, keep a distance of at least one-meter from other people.
- When entering and leaving a lecture room or classroom, read the QR code displayed in each room or seat, and register the entry or exit record.
- Registration of your temperature is required when entering rooms. Please register your temperature at the time of entering the building.
- If you feel unwell after entering the building, please contact the instructor in charge of the class or the Academic Affairs Section on the number mentioned above.
- When entering or leaving a lecture room, be sure to disinfect your hands with the alcohol disinfectant solution at the front of the classroom.
- In lecture rooms, etc., open doors and windows for ventilation. (Please cooperate with opening and closing the doors and windows). In addition, windows for ventilation will be opened as appropriate.
- In lecture rooms, etc., use only the seats that you are permitted to use, and sit at a distance from other students.
- After use, please disinfect the shared desks, chairs, equipment, etc. with the disinfectant solution, disinfectant wet tissue, etc. placed in the classroom.
- For the time being, Lecture Room 1 in the General Lecture Building will be open for viewing online classes (8:30 to 17:50 on weekdays) and for meals (11:30 to 14:30 on weekdays). When watching a lesson or eating, please use only the permitted seats and enter the QR code of the seat. Also, keep quiet indoors and avoid conversations while

watching or eating. Eating in other lecture rooms is prohibited, however, drinking water is allowed.
